Large in-house trade fair at SR Schindler Maschinen – Anlagentechnik GmbH

About 200 concrete block specialists from Europe, Russia and the Middle East visited the demonstration of a complete refinement line for concrete and concrete caststone blocks on the 4 days of the exhibition. From 14 to 17 September 2011, SR Schindler demonstrated the different post-treatment processes on the dry side twice daily with a fully automatically working plant. Raw products were bush hammered/ aged, curled and coated so that the visitors were subsequently able to directly compare the different surfaces with one another.

Surface coating was introduced as a new development. Here, the products are pre-heated by infrared heating, then sprayed with the appropriate surface protection coating and finally dried by infrared radiation. The TopCoat surface protection coating was developed by a Polish chemist and is marketed by the Chemtech Bayern company. During the in-house trade fair, chemists von Chemtech provided the visitors with technical information and the Riedel company, abrasives experts from Rheinböllen and suppliers of the grinding segments for the SR-Schindler grinding machines, also presented different grinding tools for various applications. The exhibition of untreated and treated paving stones and slabs provided the visitors with a good overview of the results and possibilities of the different refinement processes. The guests were able to take individual sample products home in order to compare them with products in their own works or to have them at hand as test examples.

All-in-all, this in-house trade fair was a demonstration of SR-Schindler's capabilities and, thanks to the live presentations, was a "hands-on" event in the true sense of the words.

The demonstration plant, by the way, will be installed together with a second refinement line in a concrete plant in Poland in the coming months. CPI-Worldwide will report in detail on this.
